All visitors who are hand unloading, using recycling, HHW, or composting services, must be in by 3:30 p.m. Monday-Friday & 11:30 a.m. on Saturday.

With possible wind or lightening closures – call to check. All customers must be unloaded & out of the gate by posted closing time or double charges will apply. For more information regarding the adoption of Ordinance No. 2 (A) establishing Summit County’s program for collection, transportation and disposal of solid waste, please visit this link https://www.summitcountyco.gov/services/public_works/landfill_recycling/index.php. Fees are updated annually. All loads must be tarped or contained by its own weight, a double charge for uncovered loads. Accepted payments cash, check, and credit/debit card. There is a \$1.50 minimum and 2.95% convenience fee added to your total to pay with your credit or debit card.

2026 TIPPING FEES

Effective 1/1/2026 an additional \$1.50/ton surcharge is applied to all trash/landfill items collected under C.R.S.25-16-104.5 and 6 CCR 1007-2 1.7 & an additional \$0.26/ton for Contaminated Soil, fee schedule: January 1, 2026, through June 30, 2026: \$1.50 per ton, July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027: \$1.74 per ton, July 1, 2027, and thereafter: \$2.00 per ton.

TIPPING FEES CRITERIA

Loads will be inspected, & contaminated loads will be charged at the loose trash or C&D rate as needed, along with applicable surcharges and additional hauling fees.

Structural fill: Contains no organic material, no trash, no free liquids, and no mud. Size 1 ft. minus. Any material that does not meet the above requirements will be charged the current rate for trash along with applicable surcharges. Same size requirement for Topsoil, no liquids/mud/trash. Tandems, End Dumps etc. \$60.00 per load.

Contaminated Soil: Analyses will require additional admin charges to be determined case by case. Special handling rates may apply for any special equipment or handling needs - \$60.00 per 15 minutes.

Construction and Demolition: Asbestos free sampling inspection reports signed by a certified engineer are required 14 days in advance of estimated delivery date for all building demolition projects including mobile home demolition. This includes abatement manifests for any material outlined for special handling in the report. Reports should be emailed to Scrap.Approvals@summitcountyco.gov. Neither friable nor non-friable asbestos is accepted at this facility. Call 970-668-4290 for more information.

Sorted Construction & Demolition (C&D): Sorted C&D loads require recyclable materials to be separated prior to disposal. Materials may be segregated within the trailer or load; however, clean dimensional lumber, metal, cardboard, clean pallets, and clean concrete must be removed and placed in the designated on-site diversion areas. Once these materials are separated, any remaining non-recyclable debris may be disposed of as Sorted C&D. Loads that do not contain any recyclable or divertible materials also qualify as Sorted C&D. Qualifying loads receive reduced disposal rates based on the specific divertible materials diverted from the landfill.

Unsorted Construction & Demolition (C&D): Unsorted C&D loads contain a mixed combination of materials—including, but not limited to, drywall, wood, metal, cardboard, concrete, asphalt, plastics, pallets, and trash—that are comingled and not separated for diversion. Loads that arrive unsegregated, or that contain divertible materials disposed of together without separation on site, are classified as Unsorted C&D and are charged at a higher disposal rate.

Concrete: Contains no rebar, no mesh or backing, no manufactured stone or bricks. Maximum size 3x3 slab, anything above that size, landfilled at current C&D trash rate.

Scrap metal: Contains no barbed wire, chicken wire, or rolled fencing, rebar, cable, brake shoes or pads, propane or fuel tanks. Barrels are only accepted with lids off and cut open.

Slash, Stumps, Pallets & Clean Lumber must be separate loads for lower rates

Slash: No willows, bushes, or small cuttings

Raw, dimensional lumber only: 1x material, 2x material, 3x material and 4x material only. No treated, creosoted, painted or stained lumber. No metal hardware. No trash or other construction debris in load.

Pallets: Does not contain metal strapping, plywood, OSB, is painted or stained.

Stumps: No dirt, rocks, or additional logs or slash can go into the dedicated stump pile, CLEAN STUMPS ONLY.

Wood Chips: There is a 2-inch maximum size requirement to qualify for the chip price. The price defaults automatically to the slash rate if the product does not meet these criteria. No trash, limbs, log ends, rocks or dirt.

Green Yard Waste: No dirt, rocks, bags, willows, noxious weeds, dog waste, wood or slash for this material.

Compost & Mulch: ½ and ¼ inch Compost and Mulch for landscaping is now available for retail sales

The Safety 1st Program allows FREE recycling of Electronic Waste (TVs, DVD, VCR, Laptops, Monitors, etc.), Household Hazardous Waste (Paint, Stain, Gas Oil, etc.) and Fluorescent Bulbs at 639 Landfill Road, Dillon, CO 80435- Large quantities of these materials require appointments.

Electronics Recycling, Household Hazardous Waste, Fluorescent Bulbs:

Colorado Law, SB 12-133 bans landfill disposal of certain electronics waste from all sources, even residential. Effective 7/1/13. This facility does have a collection service & uses certified R2, E-Steward recycling companies. Items include television sets, central processing units, computer monitors or peripherals, printers or fax machines, laptops, notebooks, ultra & net books, tablets, DVD, VCR players, video display screens > 4 inches. C.R.S. Title 30, Article 20, Part 1 and 10. CRS Title 25 Article 17 Part 3

Quantities that require appointments: 25 gallons or more of HHW, 30 E-waste units (CPU, tv, monitors, etc.), & more than 50 fluorescent bulbs in a given delivery. Please call 970-668-4290 to schedule an appointment.
